

The Pedagogical Application of ICT in Learning & Teaching

There is growing interest in the use of Virtual Learning Environments (VLEs) in primary and secondary schools and this course is designed to engage those working in schools with the use of ICT in learning, teaching and assessment. The focus is on the use of the technologies and approaches made possible by the development of ubiquitous ICT in the classroom context.

This course is delivered collaboratively by the Centre for Excellence in Learning & Teaching at the University of Glamorgan and the ICT Advisory team at ESIS. Initially developed as part of the Piloting of a Chartered Teacher Programme in Wales the course has been very positively evaluated by the pilot cohort and the external evaluation team.

Who is it suitable for?

The course is aimed at those who teach in any subject at any age group through the medium of Welsh or English and if you:

- Are using, or thinking of using a VLE such as Moodle with your pupils.
- Are interested in how best to create an effective on line learning experience to meet the needs of your learners.
- Would like to be able to identify the most suitable online resources to use with your pupils.
- Want to know more about the theory and practice of online and blended learning and how this can have a positive impact on the learning experience.

What will the course cover?

During the course you will be reviewing examples of online materials; analysing a range of relevant pedagogical approaches; evaluating a variety of resources and engaging with the emergent research in ICT use in learning and teaching. You will also be devising your own content for online and/or blended learning delivery. It may also be possible to gain Higher Education credits towards a Master's degree for those who complete the assessment element successfully.


